**SUBJECT:** Extension of Emergency and Ministerial Orders

I would like to acknowledge your continued commitment to the health and well-being of Ontario families and to our vital child care sector during the COVID-19 outbreak. These remain challenging times. Your patience is greatly appreciated and your ongoing partnership will be crucial going forward.

Today, the Premier of Ontario announced, on the advice of our Chief Medical Officer of Health and other leading public health officials, the further extension of the declaration of emergency across the province and the continued closure of licensed child care centres, and all facilities providing indoor recreational programs including EarlyON Child and Family Centres. The order will remain in place until **April 23, 2020**, at which point it will again be reassessed and considered for extension.

The order to close continues not to apply to those licensed child care centres approved to provide emergency care for health care and other eligible frontline workers. Additionally, it does not currently apply to home-based child care (licensed and unlicensed).

The Ministerial order to close all publicly funded schools in Ontario schools, and school-based child care centres, remains in effect through to **May 1, 2020**.

The emergency order to immediately prohibit organized public events and social gatherings of more than five people has also been extended to **April 23, 2020**. This does not apply to those licensed child care centres approved to provide emergency care

for health care and frontline workers. Additionally, it does not currently apply to home-based child care (licensed and unlicensed).

As the COVID-19 outbreak in Ontario continues to evolve, we are committed to keeping you informed and to keeping everyone safe. Thank you again for your flexibility and continued collaboration.
