**PURPOSE**

To establish a smoke free workplace in accordance with all legislative requirements. This directive shall remain compliant with Manitoulin-Sudbury Policies, and Regulation. Where this directive conflicts with Regulation, or DSB Policy, the Regulation shall be of primary adherence, followed by DSB Policy, then by this Directive.

**APPLICATION**

Paramedics, Paramedic Superintendents and Senior Managers

**PROCEDURE**

- 1) Paramedics, patients and/or passengers shall not smoke any cigar, cigarette or other substances while in any Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB vehicle.
- 2) No person shall smoke any cigar, cigarette or other substances while either inside or within the prohibited distance (as set out in legislation) from any Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB building.
